Professor Wadim Striełkowski. Ph.D. is a Visiting Professor at the University of California, Berkeley, Professor at Prague Business School, and a Managing Director of Prague Institute for Qualification Enhancement.

His previous role included job posts of the Research Associate at the Cambridge Judge Business School, University of Cambridge (2016-2017), Assistant Professor of Economics at the Charles University in Prague (2008-2015), Vice-Chancellor of the College of Economics and Management in Prague (2010-2011), and Research Fellow at the University of Nottingham (2006-2009).

Professor Striełkowski is an author of over 150 articles in reputable academic peer-reviewed journals (including 82 articles indexed in Web of Science and 123 articles indexed in SCOPUS), as well as several research monographs, more than 30 policy reports, expert opinions, and white & green papers.
